CONNECT THE COMPUTER TO THE POWER SOURCE

One end of the power cord has a pin plugged into the electrical outlet, the other end is plugged into the port of the power supply located on the back of the case, turn the switch ON (-)/ OFF (0)



CONNECT THE COMPUTER TO THE MONITOR

Step 1. Determine the types of ports connecting the monitor to the computer

Before showing how to connect the monitor to the computer. Let's briefly grasp the types of screen connection ports to accurately identify the ports!



1. VGA (Video Graphics Array)

The first is VGA, VGA is a popular port for connecting many devices. Special gate VGA has 15 round screws and 2 blue screws.



2. DVI Port

DVI (Digital Video Interface) is a very popular monitor connection port. The port is responsible for transmitting signals between the CPU and the screen to transmit image and video signals without compression. At the same time, the DVI port supports Analog and digital.



3. HDMI Port

HDMI is an audio and video connection port to transmit data without compression, ensuring high resolution. This port has 6 sides and has the word HDMI. Compared to the two ports VGA and DVI, the HDMI port is rated higher. Currently there are three popular HDMI standards: HDMI 1.4, HDMI 2.0 and HDMI 2.1.



4. Display Port

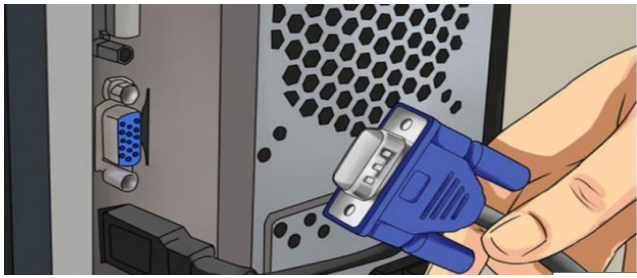
DisplayPort is a connection standard that can transmit high quality image and video data from the source to display devices such as computer screens, laptops, TVs... The identification point of DisplayPort is that it has 20 small pins.



Step 2: Plug the screen signal cable into the computer

Once you have the connection wire, you need to locate the connection port on the screen and on the PC case.

Next, just plug the 2 ends of the wire into these 2 connection ports.



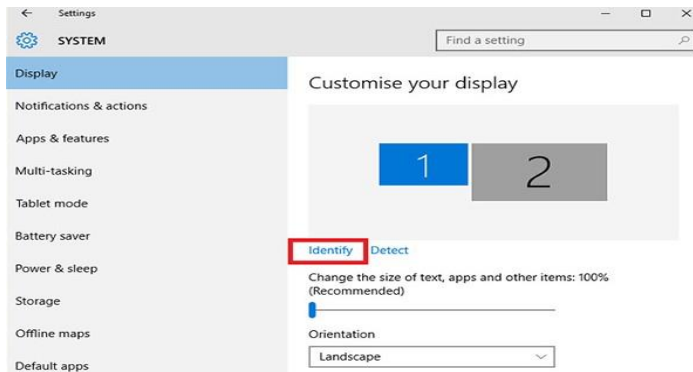
Note: When inserting, you need to determine the correct direction and pin and operate gently and slowly, avoid force or reverse direction for the connector or connection ports, try to block...

Step 3: Recheck and install the screen

After connecting the wires, you need to check everything again to see if the wires are correct or if the connection port is not secure. If you have prepared how to attach the computer case to your monitor, then when you open the PC, you can now proceed to install the monitor and start using it.

Screen setting.

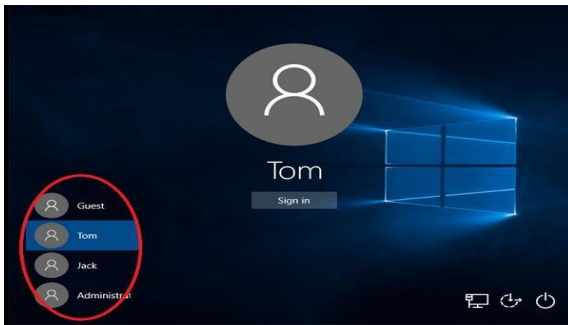
- For Windows computers: Open Settings from the Start menu > Select Settings > System (System) > Display (Display) > Customize your display.



SOME OPERATIONS ON THE MACHINE AFTER INSTALLATION

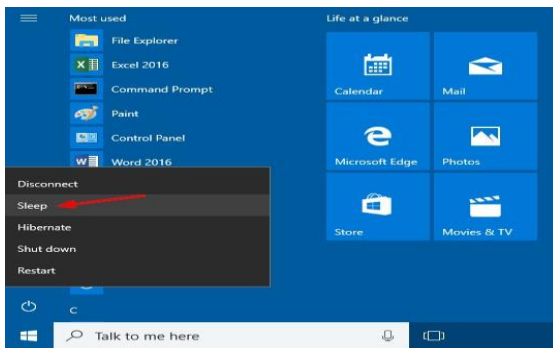
Optional account:

Click on your account name to change your account image, lock your device, or sign out of your account. This can be done from the start menu, where you will find the account name with the image.



Start Source:

Tap the Power icon to choose to sleep (Sleep), turn off (Shut down), or restart (Restart) your device.



All apps:

Click “All Apps” to see all your apps and programs listed alphabetically. Search engines can simply enter it in the “Search” search box.

Search:

Search across your device, your OneDrive cloud storage, and the Web at the same time. Just open the Start Menu and type in the search box “Search” – the Windows search program will do the rest. You can also open search directly from the taskbar; Click Search and start typing.

Pin your favorite apps:

Pin apps, programs, and folders to the Start menu for quick access to the things you use most. Apps with Live Tiles will show updates for important things.

Click “Start,” select All Apps, right-click the app you want to pin, then select Pin to Start. Once pinned, your app will appear as a tile on the right. Right click on the cell to change its size.

Drag and drop to move it.

Task view:

If you have multiple apps and programs open, there's a new Task View button so you can quickly switch between them. Click Task View to see all your running apps and programs; Select any item to open it.

Multi-screen:

If you are using different apps and programs, try adding screens. It will keep everything organized for you. Or, create one screen for what you do at work and one screen for what you do at home. Select view tasks from the taskbar, then select Add desktop. Thumbnails will display at the bottom of the task view page. Click on the blank thumbnail to open a white screen.

To switch between desktops, click Task View, then select a desktop from the bottom of the page..

FIX POWER ON FAILURE ERROR

- Check the wire connected to the power supply (5), check the power cord on another device.
- Check the screen if the power light is not on, check the power cord, the Adapter power light is on.
- If the computer does not turn on, or the computer fan is still running, the power light is on but no image appears. Please contact an authorized service center.
